

### Environmental Health


This division inspects restaurants, schools, supermarkets, rest homes, nursing homes, swimming pools, hotel and motels, etc. to insure proper sanitation.

Additionally Environmental Health workers oversee the following services:

- New well inspection and drinking water sample collection and testing
- Inspection of new and old septic systems
- Investigation of health complaints made by county officials or the general public.

### Family Planning

- Comprehensive family planning services
- Physical exams
- Routine Lab tests
- Nutrition assessments
- Counseling regarding all types of birth control, contraceptive model, communicable disease assessment, risk reduction counseling & screening.



### Health Education

The Halifax County Public Health System is committed to providing health related information for everyone in Halifax County.

Every four years we work closely with The Office of Public Health to complete a Community Health Assessment.

Additionally our staff is available for health education programs. Our goal is to promote good health by educating Halifax County residents about the causes of disease and the means of prevention on a community-wide level.

### Home Health & Hospice

Patients under the care of a doctor and confined to home may receive Home Health Care, which offers nursing, physical therapy, speech, and occupational therapy.

Home Health Care offers medical social workers and nutrition counseling to homebound patients.

Hospice services are provided for terminally ill patients.

CNAs are available to assist with activities of daily living while receiving skilled services.

### Maternal Health

Prenatal Services include:

- Prenatal Exams
- Lab Tests
- Nutrition counseling
- Health education
- Parenting classes
- Pregnancy care management
- Nurse Family Partnership

Additional services assists expectant mothers before, during and after pregnancy as well as home visits after the baby is born.
