BOARD APPOINTMENT QUALIFICATIONS AND GUIDELINES

- Any citizen of Halifax County who is eighteen years of age or older is eligible to serve on the appointed boards or commissions, unless the position to be filled is a “student” position.
- A person under 18 who meets residency requirements and shows good citizenship shall be eligible to fill a student position.
- Citizens appointed shall be full-time residents of Halifax County.
- The Board is of the opinion that those citizens current in their property tax payments set a good example for all Halifax County citizens to follow. Reappointment of current appointees will not be considered if they are delinquent in their property taxes. Accordingly, the property tax payment status for all new appointees will be verified.
- All Boards and Commissions requiring special areas of knowledge should be considered in said light.
- Unless otherwise stated by statute, the number of term limitations of the Halifax County Board Appointment Policy will be followed.
- If an appointee has absences (excused or unexcused), which constitute more than 50% of the meetings in any calendar year, he or she is obligated to resign.
- The Halifax County Board of Commissioners reserve the right to replace any member they have appointed at any time by majority vote.
